

ADVERTISEMENT FOR BIDS

The Town Manager, Town Hall, 99 Lafayette Road, Seabrook, New Hampshire 03874 will receive sealed Bids for Water Pipeline and Appurtenances for Anne's Lane, until 2:00 p.m. local time on June 22, 2017 at the Town Hall in the Selectman's Meeting Room at which time and place all Bids will be publicly opened and read aloud. Bids submitted after this time will not be accepted.

The Work consists of furnishing and installing approximately 560 feet of 8-inch ductile iron pipe, valves, hydrant, water services, temporary bypass system and related appurtenances.

A copy of the Contract Documents for the Work may be obtained from the Purchasing Office, 99 Lafayette Road, Seabrook, NH 03874 upon the deposit of \$35.00 by check or money order made payable to the Town of Seabrook. Contract Documents will be mailed to prospective Bidders upon receipt of a separate second check or money order for \$25.00 for mailing fee, made payable to the Town of Seabrook or by providing a United Parcel Service (UPS) account number.

Complete instructions for filing Bids are included in the Document 00100, "Instructions and Information for Bidders".

The total time period for completion of all Work under this Contract is 30 consecutive calendar days, excluding the permanent trench patch. It is the requirement of this Project for the permanent trench patch to be placed within 5 consecutive calendar days after a minimum 90 day trench settlement period.

Each Bid shall be accompanied by a Bid Security in the amount of 5% of the value of the Bid in the form described in Document 00100, "Instructions and Information for Bidders".

A Performance Bond and a Payment Bond, each in the amount of 100% of the Contract Price, will be required by the successful Bidder in the form described in the Document 00100, "Instructions and Information for Bidders".

No Bidder may withdraw its Bid within 30 days (Saturdays, Sundays and legal holidays excluded) after the actual date of the Bid opening.

The Owner may waive any informalities or minor defects, or reject any or all Bids if it is in the best interest of the Owner to do so.
