Application to Remove a Flammable or Combustible Liquids Underground Storage Tank

Permit Fee: \$50.00

Use this application to remove, abandon, or replace temporarily out of service stationary tank(s) for storage of flammable or combustible liquids and shall be accompanied with the following information.

- a. Site plan showing property building(s), lot lines and tank location.
- b. Tank size, age, and type of product that was stored in the tank(s).
- c. Name of qualified person at job site and in writing state education or specialized training and of contents in NFPA Standards 326 & 327. (copy of certificates preferred)
- d. Barricades and warning signs reading "FLAMMABLE - NO SMOKING" on site.
- e. Minimum of two portable fire extinguishers each having a rating not less than 80 B.C., with current inspection tag.
- f. Use of appropriate combustible gas detector and written log kept for this job.
- g. Location where tank(s) will be discarded.
- h. Copy of closure report forwarded to this office within 6 months of removal.

All work shall conform to minimum requirements as outlined by NFPA 30, NFPA 1, NFPA 326 and/or 327, editions adopted by NH State Fire Code SAF-C-6000 and local ordinance.

THIS IS NOT A PERMIT: No work shall begin until a permit has been issued by this Department and all inspections requests require a 48 hour minimum notice.

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Application to Remove a Flammable or Combustible Liquids Underground Storage Tank

The following information and documentation must be provided with the application before a FLAMMABLE OR COMBUSTIBLE LIQUIDS UNDERGROUND STORAGE TANK REMOVAL PERMIT can be issued.

All work shall comply with NFPA 30 Flammable and Combustible Liquids Code, NFPA 1 Uniform Code, and/or NFPA 327 (editions as adopted by NH Fire Code SAF-C-6000 and local ordinances)

UNDERGROUND STORAGE TANK REMOVAL	
1. Site plan showing property building(s), lot lines and tank location	
2. Tank size, age and type of product that was stored in the tank(s)	
3. Name of qualified person at the job site and in writing state education or specialized training and of contents in NFPA Standards 326 & 327. (copy of certificate preferred)	
4. Barricades and Warning signs reading "FLAMMABLE - NO SMOKING" on site.	
5. Minimum of two portable fire extinguishers each having a rating not less than 80B.C. with current inspection tag.	
6. Use appropriate combustible gas detector and written log kept for this job.	
7. Location where tank(s) will be discarded.	
8. Copy of Closure report forwarded to this office within 6 months of removal.	

The Fire Official shall be notified not less than forty-eight (48) hours in advance so they may witness:

- The tank has approved identification label affixed to it.
- Air test before tank is placed in the ground.
- Air test with all connecting lines in place and BEFORE tank(s) are covered.
