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Q7. The new wetland rules require a coastal functions assessment of marine life to be impacted. We are anticipating the need for a one day investigative dive along the fisherman portion of bulkhead.... Would the Town support restricting boat use of that area of the bulkhead the day of the dive?

A7. Yes with proper advance notice requirements.

Q8. We are anticipating the need for investigating the backfill and condition of the bulkhead...can the town provide a backhoe and operator for test pit investigations?

A8. Yes, with proper notice.
