310 Highway Department

John Starkey, Public Works Manager presented the highway department highlights in the proposed 2020 budget. Bill Manzi, Town Manager stated to the board that the Board of Selectmen recently voted to classify the DPW department as a safety department, the BOS approved Starkey's approval to hire 2 new full timers in 2020 towards the end November going into December. The budget being presented tonight includes the two new full timers, one in rubbish (330) and one in highway (310) for one month of expenditures in 2020. Starkey explained that he doesn't quite know what this winter and future winter are going to look like but is his duty to give the residents the service they deserve therefore 2 part timers need to be full time. Starkey said in the next couple weeks he is going to be laying off a couple part timers as they hit their hour threshold for the year already, therefore he is going to have to find more part timers for the rest of this year. J Brown asked when someone goes to get a CDL license instead of a test is it going to be class as she has heard recently, Starkey said yes that is true it is going to be a state class that applicant will have to take to receive a CDL, which will take more time and be more money. R Maguire asked why the part time line 310-112 was so low year to date; Starkey explained that it is really hard to disperse all the time over Parks, Highway and Rubbish as all of his employees work all over the place. A Khan asked Starkey and Manzi if all the parttimers can be placed in one department, Manzi said yes and doing that will lead to less confusion and questions. Discussion was held about the gas pumps located at the Fire Department and how inaccurate they are and it is crucial to get them replaced. Manzi stated he is looking at other towns and vendors and it is proposed to be a warrant article on the 2020 ballot.
