Lacey Fowler presented her budget to the committee. She explained that as of now she is the only full time building inspector along with her secretary that is also full time. She stated that both of their positions are divided in half between the 210 and the 410. Fowler said that she has out sourced for electric and plumbing and that is why line item professional services has increased. The committee and Fowler discussed the fee's, and would like to explore raising them, Ravi stated he will bring it to the Board of Selectmen for review.

Bill Manzi presented all budgets below to the committee. Manzi explained that the 120 is his department that is staffed with 5 employees and that there is has been a slight increase due to contractual items. Budget 510 is the town hall maintenance budget and it is staffed with one employee, which has also slightly increased due to contractual obligations. Manzi stated that he looks over the risk management, legal services, and debt budgets. Committee members had questions about the legal services account regarding next era, Manzi stated that next eras license has been renewed until 2050 and that they are going to start negations with next era in 2 years and is going to be a legal battle. Diburro asked about the revenues for the town managers budget, as over the past few years the revenue has been between \$700,000 – \$800,000 and the 2023 expected revenue is set at \$569,740, and would like to raise that amount to be more accurate to past revenues and would like to raise that number to \$719,740 which adding \$150,000 to line item "room and meals tax. Manzi stated that the current debt budget has gone up due to the new police radios and the town pier that the voters voted in the past town election.

Manzi stated that the chairman of the Trust Fund, Conservation Committee, Planning Board and Zoning Board asked him to present their budgets as there hasn't been any changes. Committee members discussed the revenues for the planning board and would like to lower the revenues to be more accurate to the past years numbers, as a result, line item Application Fees was cut to \$25,000 and line item Reimbursement Expenses was cut to \$35,000.

520 Water and 521 Sewer

Curtis Slayton, Water & Sewer Superintendent presented his budget to the committee. Slayton stated that the increases of his budgets are due to contractual items and supply increases. Committee members asked why the health insurance has gone up in the water budget, Slayton stated that some of the plans have changed due to upgrading some plans to family plans, because of new staffing. There were comments and questions on how the water department is self sufficient as the water fees cover the whole budget of the water department, but how can we do the same with the sewer to help the deficit. Ravi stated that the Board of Selectmen plan on speaking about this issue in the future.
