Separate sealed BIDS for the construction of: *Seabrook Wastewater Treatment Facility Climate Resilience Implementation Project* will be received by the Town of Seabrook at the office of the Town Manager C/O Shaylia Wood 99 Lafayette Road, Seabrook, NH 03874 until **2:00 PM Local Time on Wednesday January 21, 2026** and then at the Selectmen's Meeting Room publicly opened and read aloud. Reference Bid B2026-SWR-18 on package.

1. Completion time for the project will be calculated as calendar days from the date specified in the "Notice to Proceed" as follows:

Calendar days for substantial completion: 220  
 Calendar days for final completion: 250

Liquidated damages will be in the amount of \$1,300, for each calendar day of delay from the date established for substantial completion, and \$1,300 for each calendar day of delay from the date established for final completion.

2. Each General Bid shall be accompanied by a Bid Security in the amount of 5% of the Total Bid Price.
3. The successful Bidder must furnish 100% Performance and Payment Bonds and will be required to execute the Contract Agreement within 10 days following notification of the acceptance of their Bid.
