Chief Everett Strangman and Deputy Chief Lawrence "Koko" Perkins were present for this meeting.

Chairman Khan opened the meeting at 2:00PM. Mr. Khan explained the reason for having this emergency meeting. Mr. Khan stated per RSA 91-A:2 (b) "emergency means that immediate action is imperative and the physical presence of a quorum is not reasonably practical within the period of time requiring action" at the Town Hall in Seabrook, NH at 2:00 p.m. on Wednesday, August 28, 2013. The meeting will be public and is to authorize the purchase of an ambulance as the Town currently is operating 2 ambulances and with the Labor Day holiday approaching will be cause for a public safety issue. He said if they post for a regular meeting it requires 24 hour notification and the town is liable for the vehicle while in our possession.

Mr. Manzi said this vehicle needs to be insured immediately and they are down to 2 ambulances and with the holiday weekend approaching it constitutes a public safety concern.

Chief Strangman agreed and said if something were to happen to one of the other ambulances they would only have one.

Deputy Chief Perkins said they could not put the old ambulance back into service as the equipment has been transferred to the new ambulance.
