He said some of the officers have had training and the certification will continue. Chief Currier said 9 officers are certified and Sgt. Allen and officer Richardson are instructors.

Sgt. Allen explained the two different ways the taser could work. He said a benefit of the taser is immediate recovery for the individual. The taser has no effect on individuals with pacemakers.

Chief Currier said the taser would be carried on the opposite side than the gun so there would be no confusion to the officer.
