MONTHLY MEETING - WATER DEPARTMENT

Curtis Slayton was present for his monthly report.

Water Plant - the construction is continuing but it is slow due to the weather.

Billing - late fee bills were sent out to 709 accounts for about \$8K. 808 overage bills were sent for about \$57,381. 120 bills for commercial/industrial accounts for about \$19,225.

Mr. Khan questioned the bill for 20 cents to a resident and asked Mr. Slayton to bring a recommendation to the Town Manager as to what he can waive. Mr. Slayton said it is being addressed in the rate study and he hopes that it will be discussed when the Selectmen make their decision.

Gravel Pack Well #4 - a pole that supplies power has tipped to the south and is causing some damage. A new pole will be installed and some additional line was given so no more damage to the building.

DES - did a sanitary survey and were impressed with our wells. They will be making a report to the Selectmen. This survey needs to be completed every 3 years.

Training - employees attended training to meet the requirements for safety. Mr. Slayton is trying to be proactive to help with the cost for our workers compensation insurance.

Articles - Mr. Slayton said the vehicles for the department are old with a lot of miles. The bed is completely rotted on the vehicle. He doesn't intend to spend any money on this truck. He appreciates any support the taxpayers will give him on this article. Also the article for hydro fracturing of well #5 will help bring the pumping capacity back up for this well. There was general discussion on why the articles need to pass this year for the department. Mr. Kelly commented that an individual made a comment on the vehicles we have in town representing the Town.
