Mr. Kelly opened the meeting at 10:00AM.

Mr. Kelly commented about the ground breaking ceremony for the water treatment plant. He thanked the people on behalf of the Board for passing the article and the staff for working on the project in all aspects of it.

## MONTHLY MEETING - DPW MANAGER

John Starkey was present for his monthly report.

<u>Transfer Station</u> - there is a state permit and a federal permit to operate the facility. Now a sample for stormwater has to be done and recently metal was detected and exceeds the EPA levels. The engineer has suggested cleaning the parking lot, pipes and catch basins, this will be done on November 19.

<u>Governor Weare Lane</u> - Mr. Starkey will be attending a meeting in Concord to obtain the land.

<u>Part-time Employees</u> - 3 have received their CDL and 2 will be getting them in the next couple of weeks.

<u>Cross Beach Road</u> - received a letter from a resident commending the DPW crew for the work they did.

<u>Highway Block Grant</u> - last payment was received on November 13 so when move forward in the spring there will be money to start a little sooner.

<u>Hillside Cemetery Wall</u> - expensive to fix and may require a warrant article. Grant money is available and Mr. Starkey is going to try and get it. Mr. Khan said if any resident has historical information on the cemetery they should contact Mr. Starkey to help with getting the grant money.

There was discussion over removing the trees and what the cost would be. Mr. Starkey suggested adding language to the current warrant article to include maintenance of the cemeteries.

<u>Cemetery Fees Public Hearing</u> - Mr. Brenner went over the rates received from surrounding communities. The average is \$904.

Mr. Khan feels strongly and thinks the Selectmen should increase to \$200 and then next year increase to the \$400.

Mr. Starkey said the Selectmen need to be cautious with what they charge. Currently they charge non-residents \$200 and that is against State law.

Mr. Moore said he would agree with the increase to \$200 and to set a date for the public hearing. Mr. Brenner said the Selectmen motion to have incremental fees.
