SELECTMEN'S MEETING DECEMBER 16, 2009

Mr. Kelly opened the meeting at 10:00AM.

MEETING - HEALTH INSURANCE - RICHARD MCCANN

Mr. McCann said the committee met with the LGC two times with the union's support. When they met they discussed the concern with the rates and how the Town's rate is determined. He thinks by letting them know they were concerned and interested in the increase they came in with a modest increase compared to other Towns.

Mr. McCann discussed what the Selectmen are involved with when they become a Selectman. He said other towns pay elected officials a lot more than what Seabrook does. He said they can be compensated with cash or benefits and the Selectmen have been offered health insurance for years and he feels the taxpayers are getting a big bang for their buck.

Mr. McCann said the employee contracts have locked the Town into certain things. He hopes everyone realizes it does cost money for those things and the employees have not received a pay increase.

There was general discussion on the house bill that will tax people if they have the so called "Cadillac" insurance and also people who have no insurance. Mr. Moore said he thinks they haven't asked the employees to pay part of the premium as some employees have not had a pay increase in 6 years. He believes the injuries are down. Mr. McCann said also the experience rate for the health insurance is also down.

Mr. Khan asked about combining all 3 insurance policies (helath, workers compensation and property liability) with the LGC to get a better rate. Mr. McCann said they were looking into that but haven't received anything back from the LGC. He talked about the grouping so they do get a better rate.

Richard McCann left the meeting at 10:22AM.

MONTHLY MEETING - WATER DEPARTMENT

Curtis Slayton was present for his monthly report.

<u>Water Treatment Plant</u> - went over what the contractor is doing. The goal is to get the decking done by Christmas.

<u>Gravel Pack Well #2</u> - is being cleaned. He is looking to get back to 250-gpm.

<u>Water Rate Study</u> - is nearing completion. The Selectmen should receive a report by January.

<u>Certifications</u> - 2 employees are certified to test Town owned backflow devices. This saved the Town \$1600.

<u>Seasonal Hydrant Maintenance</u> - has been completed about 2 weeks ago. A hydrant was replaced on Stard Road due to a car hitting it and the money was recouped.

Mr. Moore asked about well #5. Mr. Slayton said it is running but not at full capacity. The 2 new wells cannot go online until the plant is up and running.

Mr. Khan asked if Mr. Slayton could look into the employees inspecting the businesses with backflow devices to keep the money they spend in Town and help increase revenues. Mr. Slayton said he is concerned if they could complete them all in a timely manner with the employees he has.
