Mr. Khan opened the meeting at 10:05AM.

PARADE/MEETING PERMIT - FIESTA SHOWS

The carnival would be held on July 14-17. Mr. Manzi has reached out to the owners and there has been no communication. He said two emails were sent and a voice mail was left on Saturday.

Mrs. Kyle said since there has been no response from the owner she would motion to deny the application.

Mr. Khan said the company went to the planning board and many questions were asked of the owner and the planning board made a motion to waive jurisdiction and give authority to the Selectmen. They were asked to have the fire, police and building departments involved. Mr. Khan said they made special arrangements as this was to be a big event for the town and no one from the company showed for this meeting.

Mr. Manzi said the board was seeking answers to some of the fundamental questions so this event could happen and due to lack of response by the company he is recommending denial of the application.

Mrs. Kyle said the permits are beginning to be an issue and she would like the board at some point to discuss the policies for permits especially when it involves more than 50 people.

Mrs. Brown said in regards to the water ban she would like to amend the ordinance to water livestock all day. Mr. Manzi said the language they added simply says livestock are exempt so the board would not need to change it. He said the prohibition for the car washes has been added as it was left out unintentionally.

Mrs. Brown said she would also like to discuss the watering of gardens. She said because there are a lot of elderly watering gardens she would like to allow watering with a hose between

7:30PM and 9PM. She doesn't feel it is during the peak hours. Mr. Manzi said he would work with them on this but he is not recommending and suggested they consider an hour and only so many days a week. Mrs. Kyle said this does not apply to anyone with a well only those who are on the town's water system. She said they should also put a ban on fireworks and burning permits. Fire Chief Edwards said they go by the state recommendation and currently they are under no restrictions. Mrs. Kyle said if there is a water ban there should be no burning at all. Mr. Khan said if the fire chief is not recommending a policy he is not going to support a motion at this time. Chief Edwards said burning in a barrel is prohibited and if the fire department finds someone doing this they can pull the permit and fine them up to \$2K.
