Attorney McKittrick was present for this meeting. Attorney McKittrick explained this was for alleged non-payment of hours that had been worked. A settlement has been made through mediation and once submitted to the court it becomes a public record. The payment is for \$195K plus attorney fees and retirement costs.

The court order will be issued in the next couple of weeks and any other details should not be discussed until such time.

Mr. Manzi thanked Attorney Joe McKittrick and former Interim Town Manager Joe Titone for their hard work on this case.

There was discussion on the rates for the NH Retirement. The 2013 rates are much higher but it has not been determined yet as to what rate will need to be paid. Attorney McKittrick said if this went to court and they were awarded all of the stipulations the figures would have been substantially higher.

Mr. Khan said the Selectmen would discuss where the money will come from in a future meeting. The final figure to each fireman will be in the settlement agreement when it is released. The firefighters will be paid for all hours worked after the first pay period in August.

Angel Chiaramida asked why this was not filed as a grievance. Attorney McKittrick said this is one of those questions he would prefer to discuss after the court approves the settlement.
