Chairman Khan opened the meeting at 10:00AM.

Mr. Hess said the Board has a request from George Dow to have the fence viewers to and review a fence at his property line. Mr. Titone explained how the request came in and why the Selectmen are involved.

MEETING - D'ALESSANDRO FUNDS

Chief Bitomske explained what the funds would be used for (see attached).

Mr. Smith asked for paperwork on this account so he can understand how the money goes in and how it goes out. He wants to know how it happens and if there is any minimum or maximum amount of spending. He would like to hold off on approving any additional money from this account until he better understands it.

Mr. Hess said he doesn't feel this should wait as it could affect his department.

Mr. Khan said the money has been spent to quickly and the rules says it is to be spent strictly for law enforcement purposes not the Seabrook police department he feels there is a difference. He is also concerned with the vehicles that have been purchased. He would like to wait for a new town manager to review what can be purchased and he will not support this request.

Mr. Hess said he disagrees it is money well spent and doesn't think it should wait.

Robie Beckman said if the tasers needed to be replaced why wasn't it anticipated and budgeted for. Chief Bitomske said he is trying to not go before the taxpayers for money and to use the money they were given wisely. There was discussion on the budgeting for the tasers.

Paula Wood commented that everyone is concerned with the money being spent. She said it is not her position to say where the money can be spent. She has asked for the information on the vehicles that were purchased from the Police Chief.

Chief Bitomske said he doesn't want to speak out of line but he has been as transparent as he can by giving as much information as possible for all of the purchases he has made.
