1. CALL TO ORDER: 7:05 PM

2. APPROVAL OF MINUTES of:

a. October 21, 2010:

3. REVIEW BILLS: Sandy told the commission that we had to replace the game room floor due to the pipe breaking. Also we replaced the weight room floor. We were also able to get the golf cart that we have needed to get. Sandy expressed that she was very happy that the Town Manager let her get stuff done that needed to be done out of the 2010 budget.

4. MONTHLY REPORT: October-December- Aboul stated that the gym floor looks good. Sandy told the commission that Mike Knapp will be building two benches that will go in the game room, where the heaters use to be.

The Community Forum was held on November 16, 2010. There were 93 people that attended the event. The Commission agreed that it was a wonderful event, and turned out to be a success.

5. ANNUAL REPORT: The annual report is all set, and will be in the 2010 Town Report.

6. PROGRAMS:

a. Winter Programs: We had a slow start to our winter programs. January is normally a slow start.

b. Winter Sports: Basketball has been going very well this year. We had to add a few teams to our program this year. Bidy ball leagues added 2 teams+ and to our Junior 6th-8th Grade League.

We have a high school league this year. We joined a new league out of Plaistow, Eastern Basketball Organization. The organization consists of 6 teams from: Plaistow, Newbury, Tewksbury, Beverly, Danvers, and Seabrook. We have 12 kids on the team, and Coca Cola is sponsoring them.

c. Special Events: Our events are all going well.

7. BUDGETS GENERAL-INFO: For the 2011 budget we received what was proposed. We didn't add to the budget this year. Sandy stated that there would be more income coming in this year. Aboul asked if how much it would cost to get the front offices, and the multipurpose rooms tested for mold. Sandy told the Commission that she would look into it.

8. FACILITY REQUEST POLICY-SELECTMENS REVIEW: The Selectmen suggested changing the wording on the use of alcohol. Jessica suggested that Sandy write a letter to local business that would be interested in renting out the facility; i.e. Gymnastics, Karate, Dance, Cheerleading.

9. MEMBERSHIP PLAN FOR NON-RESIDENT FOR 2011-SELECTMENS REVIEW: The Selectmen are fine with the membership plan, as long as the Recreation Commission is fine with it.

Aboul noticed the wording in the opening paragraph was incorrect. As it reads now “Anyone joining the Community Center is entitled to use the Seabrook the following...” needs to be changed to “Anyone joining the Seabrook Community Center is entitled to use the following...”

10. COMMUNITY CENTER: We still have the issue of the tree that fell down into the brook last winter. Sandy stated that we have yet to remove it, because it is holding up the banking that the playground stands on. We will be having someone look at it this spring.

Aboul asked how the new custodian was working out. Sandy stated that he was working great. He has been up on the roof a lot. Sandy also expressed that we have been hit hard this winter, everyone has. The roof has been leaking in some spots, mostly the multipurpose rooms, and kitchen. This past storm our snow blower was not working, and Mitch had to shovel the trash drive by hand. When we called the DPW for a plow to come over, they were too busy to help. The Snow blower has been fixed now.
