**Dredge and fill applications/permits:**

- The Conservation Commission received a copy of the NH DES Wetlands Permit Application for 126 Ocean Boulevard. This project proposes to construct a small swimming pool in a previously disturbed dune area impacting a total of 220 sf. This impact will be mitigated by the planting of 417 sf of American Beach Grass.

**Correspondence:**

- Pat Pietrowski sent Sue Foote and the conservation commissioners' email regarding the west end of Cross Beach Road, which is town property. She would like the conservation commission to help her build a pocket park in that area. This area will be the ideal place to launch a kayak, go bird watching, swim at high tide or just enjoy the quietness of the beach. The conservation commission has voted on dedicating \$10,000 to the pocket park on Cross Beach they would like to purchase 2 resin commercial grade picnic tables and put a ballard and chain to designate the area which the town owns and people can enjoy.
