**Directions from Massachusetts and points South**

1. From I-95 North, take the Salisbury exit - Massachusetts exit 60. At the end of the exit ramp, you'll merge onto a road and immediately come to a traffic light. You will see a Dunkin' Donuts on the corner diagonally to your left. [mile 0]
2. Continue straight through this light and drive 0.2 miles to a second light at Route 286 East [mile 0.2]
3. Turn left onto Route 286 and stay on it until you get to the Wastewater Treatment Plant driveway. Landmarks along the way are:
  - after 0.5 mile through a mostly residential area, you'll come to a traffic light at Route 1 - continue straight [mile 0.7];
  - after 0.5 mile more, you'll come to a blinking light - continue straight [mile 1.2];
  - after 0.3 miles you'll come to another traffic light - continue straight [mile 1.5];
  - after 1.1 miles you'll come to the drive for the Wastewater Treatment Facility on your right [mile 2.6].
  - *(If you get to Markey's Lobster Pool Restaurant on your right or Brown's on your left, you've gone too far. If you reach the traffic light where Route 286 dead ends into Route 1A at Seabrook Beach, you've gone way too far.)*
4. Turn right onto the drive for the Wastewater Treatment Facility, cross the causeway, and park at the Administration Building (first parking lot on your right).

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**Directions from Maine and points North**

1. From I-95 South, take the Seabrook exit – New Hampshire exit 1.
2. At the end of the exit ramp, turn left onto Route 107. [mile 0]
3. Continue on Route 107 for 0.5 miles to the traffic light at Route 1. [mile 0.5]
4. Turn right on Route 1 South and go 1.2 miles at which point the road will divide. [mile 1.7]
5. Continue on for about 100 yards from where Route 1 divides, getting into the left lane just as soon as possible.
6. Where the lanes forks, bear left. Then **immediately** merge over to the right lane and bear right.
7. Proceed another half mile on Route 1 South to the traffic light at Route 286. [mile 2.3 ]
8. Turn left onto Route 286 and stay on it until you get to the Wastewater Treatment Plant. Landmarks along the way are:
  - after 0.5 mile more, you'll come to a blinking light - continue straight [mile 2.7];
  - after 0.3 miles you'll come to another traffic light - continue straight [mile 3.0];
  - after 1.1 miles you'll come to the drive for the Wastewater Treatment Facility on your right [mile 4.1].
  - *(If you get to Markey's Lobster Pool Restaurant on your right or Brown's on your left, you've gone too far. If you reach the traffic light where Route 286 dead ends into Route 1A at Seabrook Beach, you've gone way too far.)*
8. Turn right onto the drive for the Wastewater Treatment Facility, cross the causeway, and park at the Administration Building (first parking lot on your right).
